Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

1. When is the 2018 General Elections?

The next General Election will be held sometime between April and October 2018.

2. How long does it take for Fijian Elections Office (FEO) to pay out PO Allowances?

If the applicant's details are correct (Fiji National Provident Fund card (FNPF), Tax Identification Number card (TIN) and bank account details) then payment will be facilitated in 2 to 4 weeks. The applicants should update their details with FEO if there have been any changes.

3. Why haven't I been assigned yet?

If the applicants Polling Station preference [preference 1, preference 2, preference 3] has been filled then they will be in the Reserve Pool. They may be utilized during 2018 General Elections if the need for replacement arises.

4. Why haven't I been called?

If you have not been called then you are in the Reserve pool and have not been assigned due to your polling station preference [preference 1, preference 2, preference 3] being filled. The applicants who are assigned will be notified by SMS and a phone call from FEO.

5. Which Polling Station will I work in during the 2018 General Elections?

- If you have signed your Election Official (EO) contract then the Polling station will be stated on page 2 of your contract.
- It is the Polling Station venue preference that you had chosen during the recruitment drive.
- If there are any redeployment then FEO officials will make prior contact with the EO to seek their consent.

6. Has the EO Package Distribution concluded?

- The EO package distribution is continuing at the Divisional Offices.
- An EO applicant must present their Voter Registration card (EVR) and their signed contract to collect a package.
- If changes are made to the EO package distribution schedule then it will be advertised.

7. Has the Contract Signing for EO concluded?

- The EO Contract Signing is continuing at the Divisional Offices.
- An EO applicant must present their EVR card to sign their contract.
- If changes are made to the Contract Signing schedule then it will be advertised.

8. What are the requirement for the Recruitment Drive?

- The requirements for participating in the recruitment drive is having a hardcopy of your valid bank account details, TIN and FNPF card.
- You must present your Voter Registration card (EVR) with the said details to undertake the recruitment drive test.
